

## 'Coming Along Nicely'

Private Trumpowitz, 25, was wounded May 31 in Italy. In a recent letter to his sister he said he had received fractures of both legs, but was "coming along nicely" and receiving "wonderful treatment". He was awarded the Purple Heart. Private Trumpowitz entered the Army June 1, 1943, and went over seas in September, 1943, after training at Camp Wheeler, Ga.
